

Nursery Sick Policy

For the health and safety of all children, nursery staff and children's parents, children that have had the following symptoms within the last **24 hours** will not be allowed to check into the nursery:

- A known or suspected infectious illness
- A fever within the past 24 hours
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or is feeling unwell
- Cough, sore throat, croup (except in the case of allergy)
- Colored runny noses
- Common Cold
- Contagious skin rash
- Pink eye or other known eye infections
- Lice
- Impetigo (infected wounds), boils, untreated ringworms
- Any symptom of usual childhood disease such as mumps, measles, chicken pox, hand foot and mouth, etc.

*If anyone in your household has tested positive for COVID-19 please do not come to the nursery for **10 days**. You must be symptom free before returning.

*If anyone in your household has been exposed to COVID-19 please do not come to the nursery for **5 days**. If there are NO SYMPTOMS after the 5 days, you may return to the nursery.

If a child has been checked into the nursery and staff/volunteers notice any of these symptoms, parents will be sent a text message through KidCheck to pick up their child from the nursery.

The nursery staff and volunteers will **NOT** administer any form of medication to children checked into the nursery.
