UNSHAKEABLE HOPE

If God Is For Us, Who Can Be Against Us?

What, then, are we to say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us? 32 He did not even spare his own Son but gave him up for us all. How will he not also with him grant us everything?

Romans 8:31-32 CSB

If God has already given us His greatest gift that is Jesus –Why would we doubt His love now?

No Accusation Can Stand

Who can bring an accusation against God's elect? God is the one who justifies. 34 Who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is the one who died, but even more, has been raised; he also is at the right hand of God and intercedes for us.

Romans 8:33-34 CSB

Jesus isn't merely our Savior from the past. He's our Advocate today.

Our Trials Cannot Separate Us

Who can separate us from the love of Christ? Can affliction or distress or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? 36 As it is written: Because of you we are being put to death all day long;

we are counted as sheep to be slaughtered. 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

Romans 8:35-37 CSB

Nothing Can Separate Us From God's Love

For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:38-39 CSB

His love is stronger than every force that comes against you.

- **When life shakes—God is unshakable.**
- **When storms come—Faith keeps its eyes on Jesus.**
- **When anxiety rises—God gives peace that guards our hearts.**
- **Our hope is secure because God's love never lets go.**

BRIEF RECAP

Romans 8:31–39 reminds us that our hope is secure because it rests in God's unchanging love. Since God has already given us His greatest gift—Jesus—we can trust Him with every challenge we face. No accusation can condemn those whom God has justified, no trial can overcome His purposes, and nothing in all creation can separate us from His love. In an unstable world, our hope remains unshakable because God never lets go of His children.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

1. Romans 8 asks, "If God is for us, who can be against us?" How does that truth change the way you face fear, uncertainty, or opposition?
2. The sermon reminds us that Jesus is not only our Savior but also our Advocate who intercedes for us. How does knowing that Christ is praying for you strengthen your faith and hope?
3. Paul declares that nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ. Which promise from Romans 8:31–39 speaks most to your current season of life, and why?
