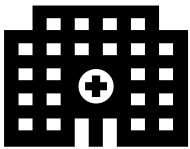
Events / Activities:

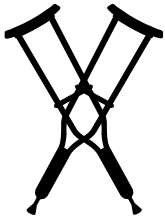
