Several years ago, Subaru ran a commercial to unbelievable good news.

communicate The commercial begins with a wide angle view of flashing emergency lights beneath a highway overpass that illuminate the remains of a severely damaged car loaded onto the back of a tow truck. The scene changes to reveal a tow truck driver staring at the wreckage and he is visibly amazed when a police officer informs him, "They lived!" Driving into the salvage yard, the smiling tow truck driver stops, and shares the unbelievable good news with a somber faced salvage yard operator, by saying, "They lived!" A verbal message of unexpected good news is shared with unbelievable surprise and joy from one person to the next.

Good news is never meant to be internalized and self-contained. It is intended to be shared. After witnessing what some say is still unbelievable, the Spirit-led Apostle Peter stood before thousands of men

to proclaim unashamedly and boldly: "We are witnesses of everything He did in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They killed Him by hanging Him on a tree, but God raised Him from the dead on the third day and caused Him to be seen. He was not seen by all the people, but by witnesses whom God had already chosen-- by us who ate and drank with Him after He rose from the dead. He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that He is the One whom God appointed as judge of the living and the dead. All the prophets testify about Him that everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins through His name."(Acts 10:39-43)

Peter, an original eye-witness to the resurrection of the One who redefined love, Jesus the Christ, could not hold back from sharing the Good News with whomever he met. Peter's personal story of Good News has been shared for hundreds of years, from generation to generation, to all who might listen. And I suspect that you have heard Peter's story
