- Spiritual guidance: counseling, preaching and leading prayers
- Emotional support : listening, comforting and encouraging
- Social services: organizing community projects and educational programmes
- Meditational : resolving conflicts and promoting peace

In rural areas, pastor might also:-

- Conduct weddings and funerals
- Visit the sick and elderly
- Support local schools through giving scholastic materials



Challenges

As pastor in rural area, you likely face challenges like:-

- Limited resources: funding, infrastructure and access to materials
- Geographical burials : remote locations, poor roads, and limited transportation
- Cultural and traditional practices : balancing biblical teachings with local customs
- High expectations : congregants needs, community pressure and spiritual warfare
