



LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

I just really, really like talking with you about the Bible. Probably none of this is new to you, but it occurred to me recently as a helpful little intro to the Scriptures. It comes in four parts.

First: One—the Bible is one story. I recently read that everything in the Bible is either preparation for, presentation of, or participation in the Gospel. It begins and ends with trees of life and God's presence in the garden. These sixty-six books and forty-plus authors present one coherent picture that comes into focus around one person: Jesus.

Second: Two—this story has two halves, the Old Testament and the New Testament. The Old Testament tells the story of Creation, the Fall, and Israel's vocation to be (or not to be) the light of the world. The New Testament picks up with storyline with Jesus the Messiah faithfully fulfilling that vocation even to the cross, his commissioning of the apostles to continue the mission after his resurrection, and the inclusion of the Gentiles (that's most of us) as God works in, through, and around us to unite all things in Christ.

Third: Three—each half has three parts. In the Old Testament, these are the Law, the Prophets, and the Writings (which include the historical and poetic works). These parts are chock full of examples to follow (or not), wisdom for living, and a steady revelation of God's covenant-keeping character that climaxes in the New Testament with Christ himself. The New Testament contains history, letters, and an apocalypse. The New Testament helps people believe, strengthens people in their faith, and shapes communities of faith in a hostile world.

Fourth: Four—four questions to ask as you read. Of course, nothing surpasses the basic "What stands out to you?" But this question can lead to subjectivism if we do not train ourselves to think beyond our biases by regularly asking: (1) What did this text mean to its original author and audience? (2) How does this text point to Christ? (3) How should this text shape my character? And finally, (4) How does this text point forward to our final, future hope of eternal life with God?


