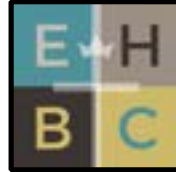

That's using your words for Him!

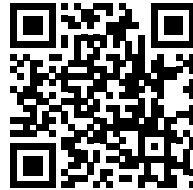
