LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

On Monday evenings, I attend a Bible study currently going through Nehemiah. One of my big takeaways from last week's study is Nehemiah's heart for the Jewish people and his willingness to serve and lead them wholeheartedly. He is the epitome of a true servant-leader.

In Nehemiah 4, enemies are plotting attacks on the fearful and discouraged Jews, stalling progress on rebuilding Jerusalem's walls. Does Nehemiah, as governor of Judah, hide out in an "ivory tower," avoiding the potential conflict and ignoring the people? No, instead he encourages them, "Don't be afraid of them. Remember the great and awe-inspiring Lord" (Neh 4:14). He develops a plan. The Jews "worked with one hand and held a weapon with the other" (Neh 4:18). The verse that really strikes me is 4:23, "And I, my brothers, my servants, and the men of the guard with me never took off our clothes. Each carried his weapon, even when washing." Nehemiah is dedicated, "in the trenches" with the people constantly, and doesn't consider himself above others because of his leadership position. Chapter 5 describes Nehemiah's devotion to the construction of the wall (v16) and that he never ate "the food allotted to the governor, because the burden on the people was so heavy" (v18). Again, we see his tremendous, God-fearing heart and care for his fellow Jews.

Studying Nehemiah fills my heart with such thankfulness, because the Lord has blessed EHBC tremendously with "Nehemiah" servant-leader pastors/directors, driven by their deep love for Him and all of you! I see Bill, Joe, Trevor, and Michael day in and day out serving this body in ways that go way beyond their job descriptions: setting up tables and chairs, lifting heavy deliveries, cleaning up bathroom disasters (trust me, you don't want to know), waiting to go last at church meals, bussing tables and washing dishes, working shoulder to shoulder on men's workdays...I could go on and on.

So, thank you, guys, for humbly demonstrating true servant-leadership and for shepherding well. We love and appreciate you!
