LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

Throughout the Scriptures we can see the dualism of light and darkness, including in the Gospel of John. From the beginning, John describes Jesus shining in the darkness as the Light of the world providing the light of life which is the hope of all who believe in Him. There are only two choices in how we receive the gospel of Jesus (the true Light), belief or rejection.

Consider the words of John 3:17-18 describing how Jesus did not come "to condemn the world but to save the world through Him" and how condemnation comes by not believing in Jesus, "the one and only son of God." Verses 19-21 reveals that the judgment is that "people loved darkness rather than the light because their deeds were evil. For everyone who does evil hates the light and avoids it, so that his deeds may not be exposed. But anyone who lives by the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be shown to be accomplished by God."

In Ephesians 5:8-14, Paul explains that if we have believed in Jesus (the true Light) for our salvation, then we no longer live in darkness, "but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of the light" which by the power of the Holy Spirit produces, goodness, righteousness, and truth. Also, we have a new ability to discern what is "pleasing to the Lord." We must avoid and "not participate in the fruitless works of darkness, but instead expose them."

In Matthew 5:14-16 Jesus said, "You are the light of the world" and "let your light shine before others so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in Heaven." Let us shine the light of Jesus on others and direct them toward the glory of God.
