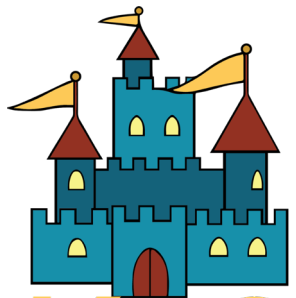

Thank you to the many Bible Study leaders and members who have offered feedback, encouragement, and support as we have worked through this process. Your partnership has been invaluable.

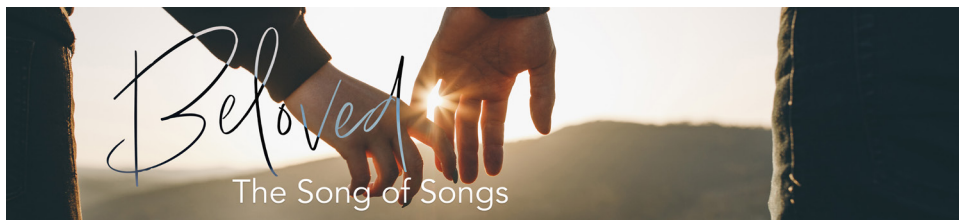
