'Experiencing God: Knowing and Doing the Will of God'-Part 2.5 (Room 303/304 -Pastor John Reed) Following the book by the same name by Henry and Richard Blackaby and Claude King, "participants will understand and apply seven realities of experiencing God, through examination of biblical and contemporary illustrations, Churches will be helped to better function as the body of Christ, as members understand how to experience God as a church." 'The Gospel Project – Volume 5 – Fall 2022 (The Grange – various facilitators) The Gospel Project for Adults/Young Adults is a study of the Bible in which every lesson "shows God's plan of redemption as it unfolds throughout scripture." This quarter's study, "From Rebellion to Exile. In I Kings to 2 Chronicles, the Israelites experienced firsthand the promise of God's discipline and judgment for rebellion—ultimately exile—but not without His mercy and patience to call His people back to Himself through His prophets. Groups will be reminded here that God does not tolerate sin, but He also responds to repentance with forgiveness and grace. (13 sessions)" Book Donation - \$5

'Bondage Breaker' (201/202 - Phil Farrar) Are you struggling with harmful habits, negative thinking, or irrational feelings? Are there strongholds in your life that are keeping you in bondage? Are you feeling trapped by sinful behavior? You are not alone. The good news is that there is hope. Join with us in discovering the truths that set people free in Jesus. You don't have to live as if you are in chains. Break through your spiritual battles and find freedom in Christ with The Bondage Breaker. - Book Donation - \$ 5

Old Testament Reading and Discussion (Library – Russ Daubert & Ken Dreistadt) In his first letter to Timothy, Paul instructs him to give his attention to the public reading of scripture (1Tim 4:13). The Greek word used can also mean "to know again." It's important for us to keep in mind that the scriptures Paul is referring to are the Hebrew Bible, our Old Testament. By reading aloud, and discussing selected books of the Old Testament, it is hoped that we will "know again" the texts that Paul was imploring his student to study, and they will illumine our understanding of the work of Christ in the New Testament. The Bible is the only required book for this class.

'The Apostles Creed: Together, We Believe' (The Grange- Josh White and Benjamin Naugle) Examine the primary tenets of Christianity. The Apostles' Creed was born from the apostles' teachings. It contains essential doctrines and beliefs that summarize the gospel and the foundation of our faith. The scriptural truths contained in the creed enable us to build our Christian lives on good theology, with the knowledge that our faith is rooted in truth and a rich history. Book Donation - \$ 10
