



2026 CBC 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting

Jeremiah 9:12 Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you.

Details: Starting Sunday, March 15th for 21 straight days we will commit to pray daily for at least 7 minutes for the Lord to do specific things)

1. Daily prayer guide, pray scripture, a Psalm a day, prayer focus on a specific need.
2. A Worship and Prayer Event on Wednesday evening March 25, 6-7pm preparing our hearts

March 15-April 4th 2026 - 21 Days Committed to Prayer and Fasting asking the Lord to do something incredible in our lives, in our families, in our church, for our city and country. Each day CBC will provide a guide and a key passage. Spend 7 minutes or more per day (in your car on the way to work, after dinner, before bed) intentionally praying.

Purpose:

- Prayer for revival for our lives, in our church and in other churches
- Prayer for a gospel awakening in our city and surrounding areas
- Prayer for a deepening of worship and devotion
- Prayer for unity as a nation and a healing of divides
- Prayer for our families and our neighborhoods.
- Prayer for our schools and our children

Sunday, March 15th Day 1 - Psalm 91:1-2 Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

- Decare - You, oh Lord, are mighty, and in charge, and I rest in you.
- Prayer - that the Lord would revive a sense of prayer and worship in our lives

Monday, March 16th Day 2 - Psalm 23:1-3 The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need.

- Decare -I Submit to the Lord my shepherd and reflect on ways he leads me and cares for me.
- Prayer - Pray a protection, a guidance, a leading for our people and a centeredness in Him.

Tuesday, March 17th Day 3 - Psalm 27:1 The Lord is my light and my salvation , so why should I be afraid? The Lord is my fortress, protecting me from danger, so why should I tremble?

- Declare -When the storms of life are raging, my God is in control
- Prayer - Thanksgiving and praise over God's power

Wednesday, March 18th Day 4 - Psalm 139:13-14 O Lord, you have examined my heart and know everything about me.

- Declare -You see my heart, you know me better than anyone and you call me beloved.
- Prayer - Pray that this day you and some of your friends can live as loved.

Thursday, March 19th Day 5 - Psalm 121:1-2 I look up to the mountains— does my help come from there? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth!

- Declare -I Place my hope first and foremost in Jesus.
- Prayer - Pray for CBC, a revival of heart and mission, for centeredness on the gospel.

Friday, March 20th Day 6 - Psalm 51:10 Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me— now let me rejoice.

- Declare -Brokenness and confession I embrace because it leads me to You oh Lord.
- Prayer - Confession and humility, pray that each of us can embrace a broken spirit and a desperation for God.

Saturday, March 21st Day 7- Psalm 37:3-4 Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you your heart's desires.

- Declare - I take delight first and foremost in the Lord.
- Prayer - Prayer for the churches in the Modesto area that they would continue to be unified and spread the gospel.

Sunday, March 22nd Day 8 - Psalm 1 Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked... But they delight in the law of the Lord

- Declare -Purify my heart and focus me on forgiveness and cleansing
- Prayer - Pray for a revival of our mission to speak the love of Jesus (the gospel) into lives inside and outside the church

Monday, March 23rd Day 9 - Psalm 35:1 Oh Lord, let me hear you say, "I will give you victory!"

- Declare - I cling to the Lord for help as others are distracted and discouraged.

- Prayer - Pray for the churches in America that we would experience a focus, a gospel light this season.

Tuesday, March 24th Day 10 - Psalm 46:1-3 God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. So we will not fear

- Declare - I run to the Lord for sanctuary and hope in a fallen world that shifts their hope to other things.
- Prayer - Prayers for the global church, our missionaries, those in persecuted countries especially.

Wednesday, March 25th Day 11 - Psalm 34:2-3 I will boast only in the Lord; let all who are helpless take heart. Come, let us tell of the Lord's greatness; let us exalt his name together.

- Declare -I won't let my heart be troubled but will let His peace wash over me.
- Prayer - Pray for the poor and struggling in our community.

Thursday, March 26th Day 12 - Psalm 119:11 I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

- Declare -I place God's word on my heart and let all other distractions fall away.

- Prayer - Pray for the addicted and abused in our cities. Pray for the recovery programs like CR and others.

Friday, March 27th Day 13 - Psalm 103:8 The Lord is compassionate and merciful, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love.

- Declare -I sing, "Bless the Lord, oh my soul!" in the midst of chaos and hurt.
- Prayer - Pray for racism and division to be healed in our communities and across the nation.

Saturday, March 28th Day 14 - Psalm 100:1-5 Shout with joy to the Lord, all the earth! Worship the Lord with gladness. Come before him, singing with joy.

- Declare -I will clap my hands and stomp my feet in joy to any frustration and discouragement I encounter this day.
- Prayer - Pray a celebration of what God is doing in building His kingdom in our community. Pray for ministries in the area - Love Waterford, Love Don Pedro, and others.

Sunday, March 29th Day 15 - Psalm 40:3 He has given me a new song to sing, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see what he has done and be amazed. They will put their trust in the Lord.

- Declare - You, Oh Lord, are my Divine Deliverer and I will sing a new song to you today.
- Prayer - Pray for our children in this community in foster care and for those who are considering abortions to turn to adoption.

Monday, March 30th Day 16 - Psalm 19:1 The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display his craftsmanship.

- Declare - With every storm I see the rainbow of the Lord.
- Prayer - Pray for your family. Pray also for the families and children in our community. Pray for the schools by name.

Tuesday, March 31st Day 17 - Psalm 42:1-3 As the deer longs for streams of water, so I long for you, O God. I thirst for God, the living God. When can I go and stand before him?

- Declare - I long for your peace to quiet my soul as I go through trials and testings.
- Prayer - Pray for your extended family, that their needs be met and that they turn to the Lord.

Wednesday, April 1st Day 18 - Psalm 22:11 Do not stay so far from me, for trouble is near, and no one else can help me.

- Declare - I may not see my way out of the darkness but I will trust in You, Oh Lord, and will bow my knees to you.
- Prayer - pray for our public servants, our firefighters and police officers.

Thursday, April 2nd Day 19 - Psalm 18:30 God's way is perfect. All the Lord's promises prove true. He is a shield for all who look to him for protection.

- Declare - When I am afraid, you calm my fears. I choose trust.
- Prayer - Pray for the neighborhoods in the East Stanislaus County areas and the connected communities (Waterford, Robert's Ferry, Hickman, Hughson, Empire, LaGrange, Don Pedro, Oakdale, Denair)

Friday, April 3rd Day 20 - Psalm 3:8 Victory comes from you, O Lord. May you bless your people.

- Declare - When people let me down, I go to the Rock that is higher than I and express it as, "Holy, Holy, Holy."
- Prayer - Pray for our teachers and school administrators.

Saturday, April 4th Day 21 - Psalm 32:7 For you are my hiding place; you protect me from trouble. You surround me with songs of victory.

- Declare - Help me to hide in you, Oh Lord, in your love, your goodness, and your grace.
- Prayer - Pray for the churches in our community and their pastors (Andrew - Hickman Community, JT - First Baptist, Dave - Assembly of God, Ed and Max - The Well, Martin - IBC, Wynter - Lake Don Pedro Baptist, and others).
