WHAT WE'LL LEARN EACH WEEK

Each week, we will cover:

- 1 **2 Bible verses**
- 2 **1 division of the books of the Bible**
- 3 **1 Key Passage**

We will also have designated review weeks throughout the year to give everyone a little break and a chance to catch up.

Every Thursday, we will send a text explaining what we covered that week so you'll know exactly what to work on with your child at home.

Our prayer is that Bible Drill doesn't stop when your child leaves church on Wednesday. We hope it becomes something your whole family can participate in as you learn, talk about, and memorize Scripture together.

RED BIBLE DRILL CARDS

Your child has been given a **RED Bible Drill Card** containing all of the material they will learn this year.

Put those cards **everywhere!** Keep one in the car, by your child's bed, on the refrigerator, in a backpack—anywhere your child will see it regularly!

The goal is to make practicing Scripture an easy part of everyday life.

HELPFUL TIPS

- **Drive time** is a great place to practice Scripture. Even a few minutes on the way to school, practice, or activities can make a huge difference.
- **Send kids to bed a little early** and use some of that time to practice.
- **In the past, kids have practiced Bible Drill** with friends at school—on the playground, at lunch, or during free time.
- **A little practice consistently** throughout the week goes a long way!
