Ephesians 2:8-9

gift ≠ work

Romans 4:4-5 “ Now to him who works, wages are not given as a gift but as a debt (an obligation), but to him who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly his faith is credited as righteousness.”

Galatians 2:16, 21

Do not frustrate the grace of God by believing salvation, and all that is included in the salvation package, comes by performance or works of obedience to the law

Thayer's Greek Lexicon - Frustrate = to act towards anything as though it were annulled; hence, to deprive a law of force by opinions or acts opposed to it

Galatians 5:4

no effect = to render idle, useless

Galatians 5:4 NASV “You have been severed from Christ, you who are seeking to be justified by the Law; you have fallen from grace”

Mark 7:13 MEV

Faith in the provision of God's grace is how we walk in the miraculous gifts of grace.

Faith in the grace of God alone saves (sozo); however, saving faith is never alone.

James 2:17-18

James 2:17-18 AMP “So too, faith, if it does not have works [to back it up], is by itself dead [inoperative and ineffective]. But someone may say, “You [claim to] have faith and I have [good] works; show me your [alleged] faith without the works [if you can], and I will show you my faith by my works [that is, by what I do].”

1 Corinthians 15:10

1) Grace Works!

Hebrews 4:10-11

Rest ≠ inactivity

Rest = assurance and confidence in what Jesus has accomplished

Faith takes us through the door to grace.

There must be a Balance of Grace and Faith.

Faith alone without grace leaves us with legalism.

Grace alone without faith leaves us with fatalism/calvinism.

2 Corinthians 13:5

2 Corinthians 4:13

2 Corinthians 9:8 "And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work."

2) Grace Abounds!

We are supposed to be abounding in every area of our lives so that there are no limits on the things God wants us to do! The purpose of the abundance is doing the work of the kingdom!

Romans 5:20 "But the law entered, so that sin might increase, but where sin increased, grace abounded much more,"

"Abounded much More" hyperperisseuō = super abound = to abound beyond measure, abound exceedingly, overflow

People should be blessed because you are blessed!

3) Grace Reigns!

Romans 5:21 "so that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

2 Corinthians 12:9

Grace is the ability to overcome circumstances, be above and not beneath, the head and not the tail!

2 Corinthians 2:14 "Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place."
