

Authority Domain



Description:

The authority domain has anything to do with guidance and direction. It includes but is not limited to roles, responsibilities, access, and permission. Healthy relationships with authority structures provide a sense of forward movement and possibility. Unhealthy relationships with authority create stagnation and hopelessness, with an extreme form looking like oppression.



Personal Example

Examples of authority at a personal level can be goals, mission statements, and overall direction for life.



Family Example

Authority structures in the family can look like the roles of mother, father, child, sibling, and extended family roles. Each of these roles will have either explicit or implicit responsibilities to the family unit.



Organization Example

Organizational examples of authority can look like the roles of CEO, manager, boss, employee, board of directors, stock holders, etc. These roles are intended to clearly define all responsibilities and decision making rights within the organization.



Government Example

Government examples can look like the roles of president, queen, congressman, etc. These roles are intended to manage all aspects of creating and enforcing laws.
