Get to Know Me

1. Are you a collaborator or a *lone wolf*?

Into the Bible

Read Acts 18:1-8

2. Still traveling alone, Paul arrived in Corinth and met Aquila and Priscilla, who were tentmakers like him. He stayed with them and worked to support himself and his ministry. Read 1 Corinthians 9:7–18 and 2 Corinthians 11:8-9. What does Paul say was his right as a teacher of the gospel, and why did he choose not to make use of that right?
3. Paul’s enthusiasm for the ministry increased when his friends arrived with good news about the Thessalonian church (1 Thessalonians 3:6-10). What does this reveal about the benefit of companionship in ministry?
4. In Matthew 10:14, Jesus instructed His disciples to shake the dust from their feet when they left a place where they and their message were rejected. How does Paul’s response to rejection in this passage compare to that instruction, and what does it teach us about our responsibility when sharing our faith?

Read Acts 18:9-17

5. In this passage, the Lord made a promise to Paul. What three things did He tell Paul that would have encouraged him to keep preaching the gospel boldly? How can those same promises encourage us as we seek to share our faith?
6. A rare thing happened in this passage, the government protected Paul rather than persecuting him. How should we make the most of the freedoms we enjoy in the United States as we seek to be faithful witnesses to those around us?

Read Acts 18:18-23

7. In chapter 16, the Lord prevented Paul from preaching in Ephesus and other areas of Asia, but in this passage, he is later allowed to minister there with great success. What does this teach us about God’s timing and the times when He says “no” in our lives?

Read Acts 18:24-28

8. After being left in Ephesus to strengthen the church, Aquila and Priscilla had the opportunity to help Apollos, a gifted preacher who needed a fuller understanding of the gospel. What does this example teach us about how we can help others grow in their faith when we recognize an opportunity to encourage or guide them?

Application

This passage highlights teamwork and the many roles involved in ministry. What role do you see yourself playing in the church, and how is God calling us to serve together and support one another as members of the body of Christ?
