Bible Puzzles Lesson 1

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE ONLY GOD



DRIVING:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

As you drive around, be on the lookout for “unique” things: out of state license plates, unusual colors of cars, etc. Talk about how God is unique; there is no one like the one true God.



PLAYING:

Make this week's lesson real:

Play a little Follow the Leader. Afterward, talk about how we follow God because he created us. There is no one else like him. There is only one God.



EATING:

Build a little campfire and supervise your kids as you make S'mores together. Talk about the fire that Elijah called down from heaven to show the people that there is only one true God.



SNUGGLING:

Snuggle up together and read the memory verse together: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Love him with all your strength.” Deuteronomy 6:5 (NirV). Talk about how we should love God because there is no one else like him. There is only one God!
