4 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With your Kids

## Jesus Fixed It! Lesson 1

### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE LITTLE FIX



#### IN THE CAR:

Next time you are stuck in a construction zone, talk to your kids about how although things look messy, the construction workers are there to “fix” what was broken. Encourage kids to remember that when our lives get messy and we face problems, we can turn to Jesus. Jesus can fix what is broken for us.



#### HANGING OUT:

Bring out the blocks (not the interconnecting ones) and build a tower together. When it gets too high, it will inevitably fall. See if you can “fix” it by rebuilding it to look exactly as it did before. Remind kids that Jesus can fix what is broken in a person’s life.



#### AT DINNER:

Serve up water with the meal. Ask each family member their favorite thing to drink. Encourage them to change the water into that drink, like Jesus turned the water into wine at the wedding. When they can’t, remind them that nothing is impossible for God.



#### AT BEDTIME:

Snuggle up together and read the Memory Verse. Talk with your child about any problems they may be facing. Offer help where appropriate. Pray to Jesus for his help to fix it.
