THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE TROUBLE WITH BENJAMIN



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Before Joseph revealed himself to his family, he tested them to see if they'd changed by framing his younger brother for theft. When the brothers begged for Benjamin's life, Joseph revealed himself and forgave them. Genesis 44-45, The Silver Cup and Joseph is Revealed



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids why God wants us to be peace makers. Ask them if there's anyone they need to make peace with and say a prayer with them for the courage to do so.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did Joseph test his brothers?
- Why did Joseph forgive his brothers?
- Why does God want us to make peace with people who have wronged us?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"The Lord is a place of safety for those who have been treated badly. He keeps them safe in times of trouble." Psalm 9:9 (NirV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Is there someone you need to forgive? Someone you need to make amends with? Ask God to help you reach out to that person this week. Forgive if you must. Ask for forgiveness if you must. Make amends if you can. Ask God to help you set an example in being a peace maker.
