THIS WEEK'S LESSON: DAD LIKES HIM BEST



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When you're one of 13 kids, there's bound to be sibling rivalry, especially when Dad clearly likes one brother better than the others. Jacob was unfair to his children, but Joseph's brothers should have remembered to draw their self-worth not from their earthly father but their heavenly father. Genesis 37:1-11, Joseph is the Favorite



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids how often they think things are unfair in your own house. Then ask them if they think God ever plays favorites or if He is always fair and loving with us.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why were Joseph's brothers jealous?
- How was Jacob unfair to his other sons?
- What should we do when we think life is unfair?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"The Lord is a place of safety for those who have been treated badly. He keeps them safe in times of trouble." Psalm 9:9 (NirV)
