THIS WEEK'S LESSON: PRAY FOR OTHERS

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:



DRIVING:

Next time someone cuts you off in traffic, let your little one hear you pray for the other driver – for their safety and wisdom. Remind your kids that we can pray for everyone, even those people that might make us mad.



PLAYING:

Little ones are always bumping into things during playtime. Next time they run to you with a bumped elbow or stubbed toe, don't just kiss the booboo and make it better. Say a little prayer on their behalf – let them hear you pray for them.



EATING:

Remember those who do not have reliable access to food. Pray that God would provide for those who are hungry and hurting.



SNUGGLING:

Cuddle up with your little one and a family photo album. Tell your little one who each person is - "that's your cousin" - and take a moment to pray for them.
