Safety Protocol

WE HIGHLY VALUE THE SAFETY OF ALL STUDENTS AT CAMP

WE RECOGNIZE EVEN IN DAILY ACTIVITIES AT HOME THERE IS ALWAYS A LEVEL OF RISK ASSOCIATED. WE ATTEMPT TO MITIGATE DANGER OF INJURY BY INTENTIONALLY PICKING ACTIVITIES AND GAMES WHICH ARE FUN AND CHALLENGING BUT NOT DANGEROUS. WE ALSO PROVIDE QUALIFIED LEADERSHIP OVER EACH AREA OF CAMP TO MAINTAIN AS SAFE AN ENVIRONMENT AS WE CAN

HOW DO WE KEEP STUDENTS SAFE?

ALL STUDENTS HAVE A CAMP WAIVER FILLED OUT BY THEIR PARENT

ALL MEDICATIONS (INCLUDING LEADERS) IS SUBMITTED TO THE CAMP NURSE AT CHECK IN

WE HAVE A DEDICATED CAMP NURSE ON SITE AND AVAILABLE 24/7 DURING CAMP

EVERY PERSON ON CAMPUS FOR CAMP IS BACKGROUND CHECKED

WE DO NOT ALLOW VISITORS DURING CAMP

WE ALWAYS HAVE 2 LEADERS ASSIGNED TO EACH CABIN
LEADERS ARE PROVIDED TRAINING ON SAFETY PROTOCOL
LEADERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE 1 ON 1 IN A PRIVATE LOCATION WITH A STUDENT

WE HAVE TRAINED STAFF AT THE CAMP MONITORING THE 60' SWING, ZIP LINE AND MECHANICAL BULL

WE HAVE TRAINED LIFEGUARDS ON SITE WHENEVER LAKEFRONT IS OPEN

WE HAVE LICENSED AND BACKGROUND CHECKED BOAT DRIVERS

OUR CAMP TEAM AND PASTORS PROVIDE GUIDANCE TO CABIN LEADERS AND HELP TO HANDLE DIFFICULT SITUATIONS

WE TEACH STUDENTS RULES AND EXPECTATIONS ON DAY 1

IF THERE ARE ANY INJURIES OR INCIDENTS, WE PRIORITIZE COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES

You will be guided to park on the far side of the chapel building as you come in (there will be a parking crew).

From there, the young men can bring their luggage with them to the front of the chapel to check in (*we encourage ladies to leave their items in the car to drive up after check in*). We will have a leader designated for Suncrest check in by the big pine tree in front of the chapel. All students must check in there.

Check in first with this leader, then if your student has any medication with them - all medications must be turned in with the Medical Form to the camp nurse just inside the chapel. Once these steps are completed your student may go to their cabin where a leader will be waiting to greet them. Ladies can then be driven up the hill near their cabins to unload their things. A leader will be there to greet them as well.

Camp Discipline

JUST AS JESUS OPERATED WITH A BALANCE OF GRACE AND TRUTH, OUR PURSUIT IS TO DO EVERYTHING WE CAN TO HELP STUDENTS GROW THEIR FAITH AT CAMP.

WE HAVE SOME BASIC, BUT IMPORTANT RULES FOR CAMP THAT WE WALK THROUGH WITH EVERYONE ON DAY 1. WE WILL DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO KEEP STUDENTS AT CAMP. WE WILL OFFER MANY OPPORTUNITIES TO CHANGE BEHAVIOR AND FOLLOW THE RULES - IF A STUDENT PERSISTENTLY INFRINGES UPON THESE RULES, WE WILL TAKE THE STEP TO CALL HOME, AND IF NEEDED, WE WILL ASK YOU AS PARENTS TO PICK YOUR CHILD UP.

BE AT EVERYTHING

IF IT'S ON THE SCHEDULE - STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE THERE AND ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE IN EVERYTHING FROM GAMES TO WORSHIP, TO TAKING NOTES DURING THE MESSAGES AND PARTICIPATING IN SMALL GROUP CABIN DISCUSSIONS.

BE RESPECTFUL

WE EXPECT STUDENTS TO DEMONSTRATE RESPECT TOWARDS THEIR CABIN LEADERS, STAFF AND OTHER STUDENTS. LISTENING TO THEIR REDIRECTIONS AND CHALLENGES. RESPECTING THE CAMP PROPERTY BY NOT BEING RECKLESS OR DAMAGING CAMP PROPERTY OR THAT OF ANY OTHER CAMPER OR LEADER. WE ALSO EXPECT STUDENTS TO REFRAIN FROM TOUCHING ANY OTHER STUDENTS ITEMS FROM THEIR BUNK, TO THEIR BAG WE WANT TO RESPECT EACH OTHERS SPACE.

WE DO NOT ALLOW PRANKS AT CAMP. IF STUDENTS ARE FOUND TO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN A PRANK - WE WILL CALL TO HAVE YOU PICK THEM UP IMMEDIATELY.

DON'T GO IN ANY OTHER CABINS

NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN ANY OTHER CABIN APART FROM THEIR OWN.

WATER FIRST AT MEAL TIMES

WE ASK THAT ALL STUDENTS BEGIN EACH MEAL WITH A GLASS OF WATER BEFORE HAVING ANOTHER DRINK OPTION. THIS HELPS AID IN KEEPING THEM HYDRATED AS ONE OF THE MOST COMMON STRUGGLES WE FACE HEALTH WISE IS DEHYDRATION. AFTER ONE CUP OF WATER THEY ARE WELCOME TO HAVE LEMONADE OR SODA THAT IS AVAILABLE ONLY DURING MEAL TIMES.
