In collaboration with the Lead Pastor, the Worship Director will recruit, lead, equip, and care for volunteers while helping shape worship gatherings that align with the mission, vision, and culture of LifePoint Church.

- Coordinate with the Lead Pastor to plan and implement worship services that align with LifePoint's mission, vision, and culture
- Develop and oversee the annual worship ministry budget
- Attend weekly staff meetings and participate in the planning and implementation of church ministries and events*
- Meet monthly with the Lead Pastor for encouragement, alignment, and development
- Assist in planning and leading worship for special events outside of Sunday services, based on availability
