Classical Christian education is vital, so we do not want to turn away families that want to be a part of this mission but cannot pay full tuition. so we have worked with as many as possible, counting on help from our donors to fill the gap. However, because many of our regular donors have also felt the pinch of inflation as well as the tension of so many ministries needing help, Libertas has seen a decrease in expected annual donations. As a result, we are making an end of the school year appeal to our friends, relatives and ministryminded members of the community to help us stay in the black as we look toward the start of the 2023-2024 school year. We are looking to raise \$100,000 by June 30 to start the fiscal year on July 1. We have relied on a healthy bank balance, but those reserves are running low. 
## Capital Campaign Underway!
