To be disciples who make disciples who make disciples (2 Timothy 2:2).

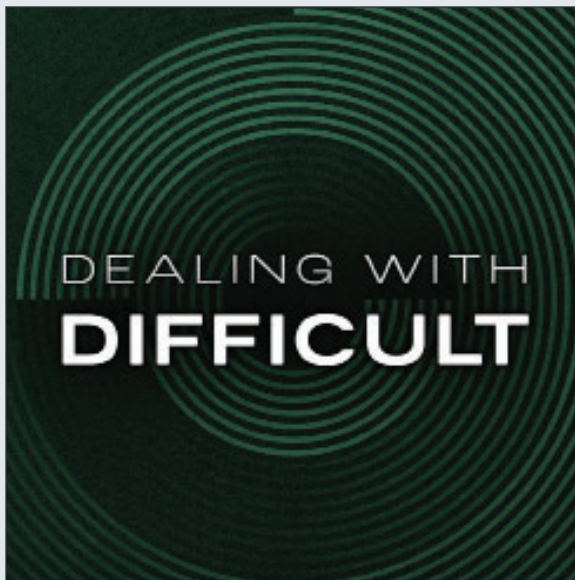
FOR OUR GUESTS

MEDICAL

John Wood: John is in New York City for a two week stay as part of his clinical trial follow up. He continues to respond well to his pancreatic cancer treatments, with tumors continuing to shrink. Encouragingly, his oncologist has indicated that the majority of his pancreatic and liver disease is now under control.

On Thursday, John's medical team performed a successful procedure to drain fluid buildup in his abdomen, bringing him immediate relief. Additional testing is planned, along with a one-time radiation treatment for a spot on his spine.

Alicia is thankful to be able to travel with John during this visit. Please continue praying for John's complete healing, and for peace and strength for him, Alicia, and their entire family.

Kathy Brooks: As many of you know, Kathy has been living with multiple sclerosis for many years. She was recently diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia and began treatment on May 18. After 28 days of chemotherapy, a follow-up biopsy will be performed to evaluate her progress.


