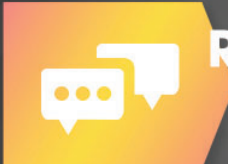

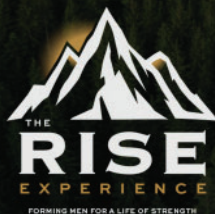

BIBLE STORY: Micah the Prophet (Micah 6:1–8)

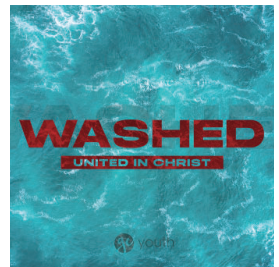

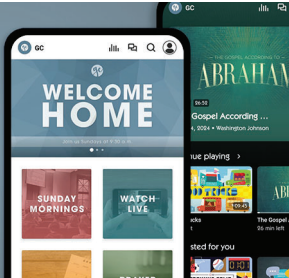

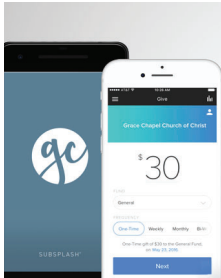
