BIBLE STORY: Delight in God's Ways (Psalm 1; Mark 13:28–31)

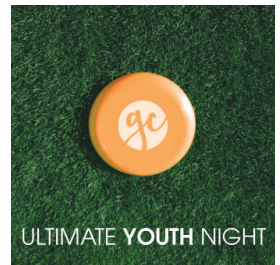

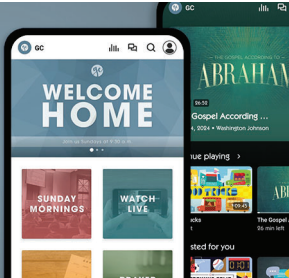
