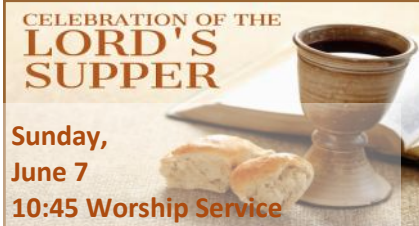

A WORD FROM TIM

Remember, Anticipate, Celebrate

Part of our joy as a follower of Christ comes from our ability to remember what God has done in the past. As we remember, a natural response is gratitude. In our personal and corporate worship, we remember that God has been faithful and we give thanks. We celebrate what God is doing, and we give thanks. We anticipate the work He will continue to do, and we give thanks.

This last week Leslie and I celebrated 41 years of marriage. In doing a Google search about the longest recorded marriage, it appears to be well over 80 years. 80 years of marriage is traditionally marked by oak, representing unbreakable strength.
