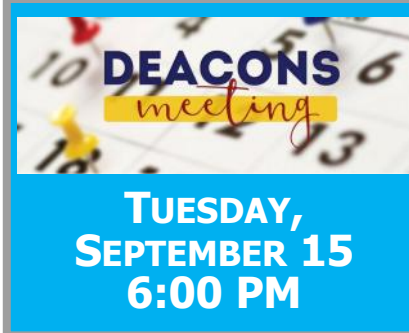

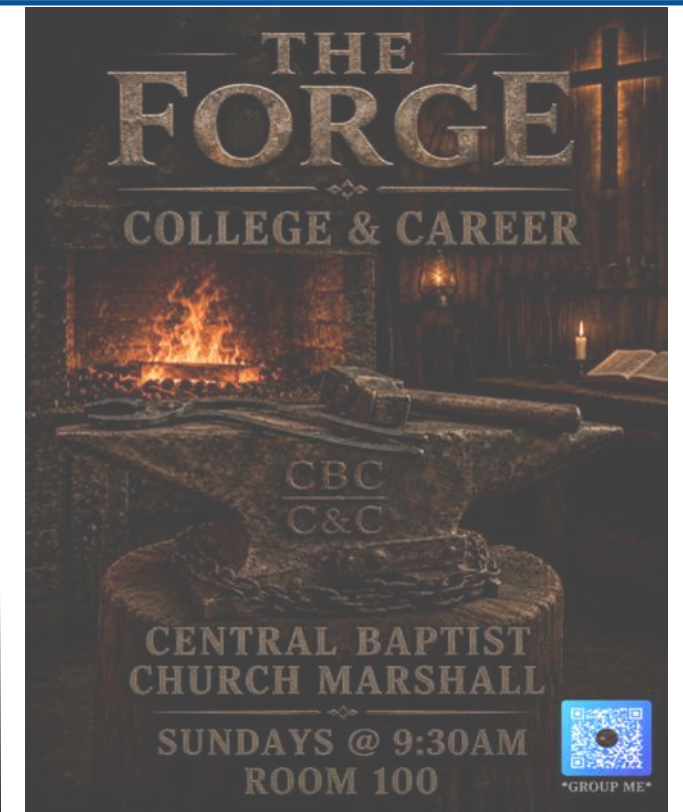
Equipping the Next Generation
