Remember that the main focus of

- Level 2 discipleship is getting the basics, i.e., the milk of Christianity.
- Level 3 discipleship is getting deeper practices and themes, i.e. the meat of Christianity.

N.B. That Level 2 discipleship does not prohibit deeper study of certain topics, but these should not cause the group to languish or drag on indefinitely. Likewise, it is possible that a Level 3 group might need to step back on a particular topic to a milk level due to member ignorance.

One suggestion might be to visit the same general topics in both Levels, but going deeper in Level 3.
