
Communion Sunday is February 15th.

Our Elevate 270 Elevator and Porte-cochere addition project has been approved by the church with an 88% approval. We want to thank everyone for their input and look forward to proceeding with the building project.

See below for the answers to some questions that were asked during the conference:

1 - Annual Maintenance/Inspection costs: \$4,000.00 annually

2 - What Brand of Elevator: Schindler

3 - What capacity does the elevator have: 3,500 lbs. or 12 people

4 - Are we Financing the project: Potential Financing had been discussed early on in the feasibility study of this project. After discussion with the Deacons and Finance Team, it was decided that we propose to the church to self-fund the project through existing funds in our Building Fund and Capital Reserves.

5 - Estimated Completion Date: September 18, 2026 (Some Factors may effect this being accurate. Elevator component lead times typically vary from 6-9 months).

Your project team will have a kickoff meeting with the architect and contractor next week to discuss a firm start date. We will keep you posted on more information as we find out more details.

Please continue to be in prayer on how we all can support this project. Throughout the project you may still give to the Building Fund, noting "Elevator Project" on your offering envelopes or on your on-line giving notes.
