Greetings in Christ Jesus,

I am writing to you asking for prayer and to tell you about what happened Saturday, January 10th as myself, and four zealous teenage brothers in Christ experienced as we went to the local mall to share the gospel.

After almost 6 hours we had many opportunities to share the gospel with Dominik, Lena, Ola, Pola, Łukasz, Michał, Olek, Mateusz, Dawid, Lidia, Zosia, Mikołaj, Olek, and Natalia.

We were all tired and ready to head home. We gathered at a table to pray for everyone and suddenly five young people asked if they could talk with us.

With pleasure, we invited them to pull up a chair. As we got into some points of the gospel they started defending catholicism. As they did we clarified what the scriptures actually teach. They were quickly offended, got up, called us a sect and Kuba (the leader), Filip, and Michał walked off. See photo attached: the five young people seated in front. Kuba is in the middle, and Maya is to his right.

To our surprise the girls, Maja and Natalia stayed. Maja especially seemed very hungry for the truth, a modern day Lydia, or Samaritan woman. After a few moments the boys returned and insisting she leave with them. She refused asking us more questions. Again after a few moments they returned, adamantly insisting she leave with them. She stayed another minute and succored to their pressure.

One brother went to talk to the guys and tried to come to a better understanding, but he was physically threatened and returned quite troubled.

We rejoiced that we were counted worthy to suffer for the gospel, though in a very small way.

We prayed and after a seven hour time together, I was the first to leave. This morning I received this text from Marcelli:

"Hi Tony,

I wanted to tell you what happened after you left.

The boys who were offended waited until you were gone. Then they came up to us very angry and started threatening us. They said that if they see us again, they will beat us, and they used other harsh and

offensive words. They also said they know you and that you are on their "red list."

The situation escalated very quickly. We tried to respond calmly and said a few words, but we also made it clear that we cannot listen to threats and that we will not stop evangelizing. After that, they backed off still angry and we decided to leave quickly.

We are actually very encouraged by the whole day. Thank you for being with us. You are truly a great gift from God.

Please pray especially for Joel he was very discouraged by what happened."

I have to admit, that in all my years as an evangelist, this is a first. I had to come to Poland to get on the 'red list', whatever that is, it is an honor from the Lord.

These three guys will sure make great bold witnesses for Christ when they get saved.

What adds another layer to this is at the end of the evening I found out the boys had been fasting. It is safe to say God answered in ways no one could have anticipated.

Also, in our encounters that day, it was the first time we met a Satanist, and two ex-Satanist lesbian atheists dressed in Goth.

It is hard not to conclude that hell's gates were rattled.

I am writing for prayer.

First for Kuba. He is a lost teenage thug with four followers. This time he bit off more than he can chew by making himself an enemy of God, His gospel, and by threatening servants of the Most High God. We do not wish the condemnation promised in

Genesis 12:3 "I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Rather, we desire for him, as well as His followers Filip and Michał, that the Spirit of God would meet their aggression to the same degree and do a miraculous work in them by convicting them of sin and righteousness and judgment (John 16:8). Also that the Spirit would open their blinded eyes to the glorious gospel of salvation and cause them to

humble themselves, be converted and follow Christ as boldly as they pursued sin..

Pray for the girls Maja and Natalia, especially Maya who was so bold to defy Kuba wanting to hear the message of life.

Pray for Joel. He is a new convert to Christ. He found Christ only through the internet, spurred on by Charlie Kirk, and reading the Bible. He knew no other true believers till a couple months back. He is very zealous, but the encounter shook him.

Lastly, pray for the 14 others who heard the gospel, as well as those who will hear in the future. That many will turn to Christ!

Though yesterday there were four teens on our team, there is another who was away (see photo of the four guys and myself).

Pray for these five young zealous servants of God.

Their names are: Marcelli, Peter (a pastor's son), Richard, Joel, and Marcinek (who was not present). After four years in Poland this is the team the Lord has given me. I am honored and thankful! 'Little is much is God is in it' says the hymn.

God willing, I have big plans for this summer, as some of them want to learn to preach on the street.

Pray for our safety and greater boldness to preach Christ crucified.
