The Flood: Part 1  
March 1, 2026

**PART 1: RECAP. HAVE SOMEONE READ THIS OUT LOUD.**

Last week we focused on how the consequences of sin are real, but we have good news of salvation through Jesus. Now, we are looking at the story of the flood found in Genesis 6 and 7. As we read through these passages, we are reminded of the seriousness of sin. Noah's faithfulness and obedience is a reminder of how God calls us to be like Him.

- If you had to pick an animal to describe yourself, which animal would you choose?
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**PART 2: HAVE SOMEONE READ GENESIS 6:1-13 AND 7:17-24 OUT LOUD. ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS AS A GROUP.**

- What do the descriptions in Genesis 6 and Romans 1 tell you about human nature?
  - How does Genesis 6 describe God's feelings concerning what has happened to His creation? How do you respond to that?
  - How does this passage speak to God's heart for justice?
  - What do you learn about Noah's character?
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**PART 3: REFLECT. ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS TOGETHER.**

- How has faithfulness and obedience to God transformed you? What do you hope God continues to do in your life?
- God is deeply invested in the wellbeing of the world. How should this affect our actions and outlook?
- When was the last time you shared the good news of salvation with someone? How did it go?
- How are you called to be faithful this week? Be specific.

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**KEY VERSE:**

Genesis 6:5-6

The Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And the Lord regretted that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart.
