## **PART 1: RECAP. HAVE SOMEONE READ THIS OUT LOUD.**

Happy Easter! We have been on a journey through the book of Genesis this year, and we are celebrating this Easter and the resurrection of Christ through a story usually not told during this holiday. We are looking at Genesis 22, where we find the story of Abraham being called to offer his only son, Isaac, as a sacrifice. In our passage we find that God provides the right thing, at the right place, at the right time. Just as God provided for Abraham and Isaac, He has also provided for us through the sacrifice of his son Jesus on the cross.
