PARENTS & STUDENTS

We are so excited about our CIY MIX trip this summer! CIY MIX is a 4-day, Middle School-only event that provides worship, powerful teaching, small groups, free time, and an environment for Youth Groups to do various things together. It is a great time for students to worship together, to grow personally in their relationship with God, and to build and grow friendships that will last far beyond the week of camp. MIX is the best week of the summer!

This is an event specifically designed for students going into 6th, 7th, and 8th grade. It is intentionally crafted in ways that will engage middle school students through tactile, interactive and fun activities coupled with Bible-based teaching and small group interaction. MIX is an event that understands middle school students need their own experience and meets them exactly where they are at. They are at a unique time in their lives where they are learning some core ideals that will stay with them the rest of their lives. For this reason, MIX isn't designed for high school students, or for preteens. It's a chance for middle school students to be exactly who they are: to play, listen, and learn as themselves.

The dates for this trip are **July 5 - 9, 2026** at Washington Family Ranch in Antelope, Oregon. This packet should have everything that you need to know, but if you have any questions at all, or questions arise as the event draws closer, please let us know!

ON SUNDAY, JULY 5th

Please arrive at ECC Central Valley no later than 5:30 AM on Sunday, July 5th. We will make sure everyone is here, go over trip expectations, and head out on charter buses.

ON THURSDAY, JULY 9th

We will arrive back at ECC between 6 and 6:30 PM on Friday, July 9th. We will notify you if we are running any later than 6:30.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

- Register online with ECC by visiting the "SIGN UP" link at eaglechristianchurch.com/ciymix
- Submit a \$50 deposit, or full payment, online when registering. Or, submit payment via check or cash to a staff member or the church office. A \$50 deposit must be received in order to hold your spot, and refunds will not be given for this trip.
- Submit final payment online, to a staff member, or to the church office. You will be alerted to the balance you still owe in the weeks before the trip.

GOOD INFO TO KNOW

LUNCHES TO AND FROM CAMP – We will be making 2 stops during our drive, first at Arrowhead Travel Plaza just outside Pendleton, and second at the Pilot Travel Center at Biggs Junction. Students will need money to buy lunch to and from camp. \$20-\$30 will be more than enough to cover both meals.

CABIN LEADERS – All of our volunteers either serve each week with students on Wednesdays or on the weekends. All of our volunteers have gone through a background check and training, and are dedicated to the safety and spiritual growth of all students in attendance. If you would like to know more about your students specific grade leader, please Reach out to the youth minister at your campus.

CABIN ARRANGEMENTS – All students will be divided into cabins by grade, gender, and campus. There is some overlap of grades as we fill beds, but for the most part, they will be with their small group from either Wednesdays or Sundays all week. Your student will have at least two leaders in their cabin. We do our absolute best to honor requests for what cabin they are in and with who, but cannot guarantee that every request is possible.

WASHINGTON FAMILY RANCH – Washington Family Ranch is a beautiful camp, and we are so excited to be there! It has a rec room, lake, ball fields, go-karts, zip lines and more! Cell service is extremely limited at this location, and wifi is spotty. CIY always makes sure that Youth Ministers have access to WiFi for emergencies, but other than this, contact is limited. There are also landlines available for students to make calls from during free time. We will not be giving WiFi to students so as to not overload the camps capabilities. All inside areas have air conditioning. There are trained medical staff on site at WFR, and we will also have a nurse with our group.

FUNDRAISING & FINANCIAL AID – We never want money to be the reason a student can't go to camp, and so we do have Financial Aid available for MIX. We ask that each student pay as much as possible, so that we can bring as many students as possible. If your family needs assistance for MIX, please contact a staff member and ask for a Financial Aid Request form. Raising money is also a fantastic option. We do not do any group fundraisers, but encourage students to raise money on their own. Figuring out how to pay for the trip also helps students feel invested in their experience while they are there.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS – We want students to have a safe and comfortable trip to MIX. We have chartered nice, high-end charter buses to get us to and from MIX safely.

PACKING LIST

WHAT TO BRING:

- **Bible & Notebook**
- **Clothes for 4 days** – plan on bringing 2 sets of clothes for the full days at camp. One set should be suitable for getting dirty or wet.
- **Sleepwear**
- **Jeans and a lightweight jacket for cool evenings**
- **Appropriate swimwear**
- **Team-Color Apparel** – we will be given a team color for camp about 3 weeks ahead of time. We will let you know in the weeks leading up to camp what our color is!
- **Shoes** – comfortable shoes for walking
- **Bedding** – sheets for a twin bed, blanket or sleeping bag, pillow
- **Toiletries**
- **Prescription medications** – to be handled by our nurse
- **Money for travel, the MIX merch station, offering, etc.**
- **Athletic equipment for rec time** (optional)

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- **Alcohol, vapes, cigarettes, drugs, etc.**
- **Knives, weapons of any kind, or anything with an open flame.**
- **Gaming consoles.**
- **Refrigerators, large appliances.**

FINAL NOTE

ECC Youth Staff members reserve the right to send any student home for conduct that violates the trip rules or CIY MIX rules. Though it is never our desire, common things that will get a student sent home include, but are not limited to: vaping, consuming tobacco at MIX, consuming alcohol at MIX, distributing pornography, or continually refusing to follow direction from leaders. Depending on the situation, in some cases staff may be required to contact the police. The parents or guardians of any students sent home are responsible for arranging transportation for a student who is sent home.
