We are so excited about CIY Move this summer! If you are unfamiliar with this event, CIY Move is a 5-day, High School-only event designed to amplify Christ's call on students' lives to become kingdom workers. CIY Move does this by providing worship times, small group times, free time, and an environment for Youth Groups to do various things together. It is a great time for students to worship together and discover ways that God can and will use them for His kingdom. Plus, it's just a fun trip!

The dates for this trip are **July 26 - 31, 2026**—though we return early the morning of the 31st. This packet should have everything that you need to know, but if you have any questions at all, or questions arise as the event draws closer, please let us know!

ON SUNDAY, JULY 26th

Please arrive at ECC Central Valley no later than 6 AM on Sunday, July 26th. We will make sure everyone is here, go over trip expectations, and head out on charter buses.

ON FRIDAY, JULY 31st

We will arrive back at ECC around 5:00 AM on Friday, July 31st. We will drive through the night of July 30th and return early July 31st. Our professional drivers will have slept through the day and will be rested for the drive. We will have students notify their parents 30 minutes before arriving.

BEFORE THE EVENT

- Register online with ECC by visiting the "SIGN UP" link at eaglechristianchurch.com/ciymove
- Submit a \$50 deposit, or full payment, online when registering. Or, submit payment via check or cash to a staff member or the church office. A \$50 deposit must be received in order to hold your spot, and refunds will not be given.
- Submit final payment online, to a staff member, or to the church office. You will be alerted to the balance you still owe in the weeks before the trip.

PACKING LIST

WHAT TO BRING:

- Money for Lunch on the way to Newberg.
- Bible
- Notebook and pen/pencil
- Water Bottle
- Clothing for five days, including travel time
- Personal toiletry items, including prescription medication
- Towel
- Bedding/sleeping bag to fit a single bed
- Footwear – plan to do a lot of walking!
- Money for travel, the MOVE Store, snacks, offering, etc
- (optional) Athletic equipment for rec time and tournaments

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Alcohol, vapes, cigarettes, drugs, etc.
- Knives, weapons of any kind, swords, lightsabers, infinity stones, etc.
- Anything with an open flame.
- Refrigerators, large appliances.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a typical day like at MOVE? A normal day will include breakfast, CIY's "Morning Show," a morning worship session, small group time, lunch, class electives, plenty of free time, dinner, an evening worship session, and youth group time. During free time, we will have some time to chill, and also some time to explore the area! We have some other things planned, but we don't want to give away too much!

Is sending my child to MOVE safe? We understand. It seems sketchy to send a student on a trip...in a bus...to Oregon...with a bunch of other High Schoolers... But, we take their safety, security, and experience very seriously. We will be taking vetted and trained adult leaders on the trip who will be assigned a group for the week. Those leaders (each leader usually has around 7 students) keep track of students and make sure things are happening in a safe way. Each leader has a cell phone so they are connected. We also do things like "roll call" anytime we enter the bus or move somewhere together as a group. Rules and boundaries are clearly stated at the beginning of the trip and with each stop. Our housing arrangements—at George Fox University—are in safe and secure dormitories. The ECC staff and volunteers, along with CIY staff and George Fox security, work hard to make sure that this trip is safe for students.

That's a lot of money. What all does it include? Because of the generosity of our congregation, we're actually able to charge families a little less than half of what the event actually costs for each student. We're incredibly thankful to be able to pass on these savings! The price you pay goes toward CIY's price, which includes programming, meals, and lodging. It also includes transportation to CIY Move, and we actually give some of this money back to students during trips and on the way back to Boise for meals. This helps make sure that no student goes hungry during the trip! Students are encouraged to bring extra money for merch, snacks, or anything else they might want to buy.

I'm not sure I can pay that much. Can I get help or raise money? We never want money to be the reason a student can't go to camp, and so we do have Financial Aid available for CIY Move. We ask that each student pay as much as possible, so that we can bring as many students as possible. If your family needs assistance for CIY Move, please contact a staff member and ask for a Financial Aid Request form. Raising money is also a fantastic option. We do not do any group fundraisers, but encourage students to raise money on their own. Figuring out how to pay for the trip also helps students feel invested in their experience while they are there.

How do we travel to CIY MOVE? We want students to have a safe and comfortable trip to MOVE. We have chartered nice, high-end charter buses to get us to and from MOVE safely.

FINAL NOTE

ECC Youth Staff members reserve the right to send any student home for conduct that violates the trip rules or CIY Move rules. Though it is never our desire, common things that will get a student sent home include, but are not limited to: vaping, consuming tobacco at MOVE, consuming alcohol at MOVE, distributing pornography, or continually refusing to follow direction from leaders. Depending on the situation, in some cases staff may be required to contact the police. The parents or guardians of any students sent home are responsible for covering the cost it will take to send a student home from MOVE, whether that be through bus, rental car, flight, etc.
