

WELCOME

Our primary goal is to provide a safe, happy, and loving atmosphere for your child.

Here are a few guidelines:

Ages:

For worship services the nursery is available to children that are **under** 4 years of age

On Sunday mornings infants through 15 months will be in the Baby room and 16 months - 3 years will be in the toddler room. During the 10:30 service, if needed due to high attendance, 3 year olds will be in room W5.

When Childcare is offered for meetings or activities in which older children will be cared for, we will divide the children up into age appropriate groups.

If you are new to childcare we ask you to fill out a Childcare info sheet. This will provide us with valuable information, such as allergies, that will assist us in providing a safe environment for your child.

Illness:

If your child has had any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours, we will not be able to accept them in the childcare area. Any of these symptoms may indicate a contagious illness, which can easily be transmitted to others.

1. Fever of 100 degrees or more.
2. Runny Nose with thick yellow or greenish discharge.
3. Congested cough, with difficulty breathing or wheezing (which is not associated with asthma or allergies)
4. Diarrhea or vomiting.
5. Rash associated with communicable diseases (chicken pox, measles etc.)

If your child has been on an antibiotic for at least 24 hours, childcare is available. If your child becomes ill while in childcare, a childcare workers will locate you and ask that you pick up your child.

Security

1. We ask that you sign your child in at the Childcare desk and document where (room # or name) you will be located on the church premises while your child is in the childcare area.

** For the safety of the children and to reduce congestion in the Childcare area, we ask that only one parent sign your child in. We will only release your child to the same parent(s) that is on the sign in sheet. We will not release your child to a younger sibling for safety reasons. We also ask that parents not enter the room. A childcare workers will be available to assist your child in and out of the Childcare area.*


Masking tape and markers are available at the registration desk.

Donations:

Each month the nursery sends home memos stating which items are necessary for the care of your child, such as: Goldfish crackers, apple juice, Lysol, batteries, etc. These may be placed behind Childcare desk or given to staff. The childcare area relies heavily on the donations of those who use it.

Snacks:

Childcare will distribute snacks to all the children except babies to ensure that your baby is not given food that is inappropriate. If your child has special dietary needs, or food allergies please inform the Childcare Director or workers.



Other Information:

We would like you to bring the necessary items to enable us to care for your child properly in the childcare area. The following **labeled items**, if applicable, are recommended:

1. Extra Diapers
2. Change of clothes
3. Plastic bottles, sippy cups or juice containers
4. Security items such as pacifiers, blankets, stuffed animals, etc.
