# The Weekly Prayer Focus Points

Let's Meditate on these things and scriptures: **1 Timothy 5:8**; **John 15:13 KJV** Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. **Hebrews 10:25 NKJV** not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. **Roman 12:1 KJV**

**WEEK 1:** We make a **kingdom Impact** when we choose To Intercede for friends and family. (Target Areas)

●**Family & Friends spending time in prayer** ●**Family & Friends worshipping with a body of believers** ● **Family & Friends seeking first the kingdom of God...** ● **Family & Friends focusing on health, financial literacy, spiritual fitness.**

**1 Timothy 5:8** Amplified If anyone fails to provide for his relatives, and especially for those of his own family, he has disowned the faith [by failing to accompany it with fruits] and is worse than an unbeliever [who performs his obligation in these matters]. **Matthew 6:33** But seek ([aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right), and then all these things [taken together will be given you besides. **Hebrews 10:25** NKJV not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. **John 15:13 KJV** Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

**WEEK 2: Kingdom Impact** is demonstrated when we present our bodies as a living sacrifice unto God. Bodies also include all members and faculties. Mental or physical power and our ability to do something. The powers of the mind and body, the faculty of hearing.

● Memory ● Reason ● speech ● Thought ● Imagination ● Will ● Sensation

Present it all unto God. Pray for retention that we all remember God's word! And exercise its use with authority. **Romans 12:1** AMPC. I APPEAL to you therefore, brethren, and beg of you in view of [all] the mercies of God, to make a decisive dedication of your bodies [presenting all your members and faculties] as a living sacrifice, holy (devoted, consecrated) and well pleasing to God, which is your reasonable (rational, intelligent) service and spiritual worship. **Hebrews 5:14** Amplified *14 But solid food is for full-grown men, for those whose senses and mental faculties are trained by practice to discriminate and distinguish between what is morally good and noble and what is evil and contrary either to divine or human law. Luke 10:19 NASB1995 Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will injure you.*

**WEEK 3:** When it comes to praying for our leaders, **1 Timothy 2:1-4** gives us direct instruction. Our leaders need God's help. All of them. It's important to remember that God is not surprised by flawed individuals in high places. has been a reality since Adam and Eve chose their own way in the garden. He knows our presidents and kings and queens are broken. So much so that He gave His son to bring redemption and provide hope for our eternal security. In the meantime, He asks us to pray for our leaders, our loved ones, our neighbors, and ourselves. Because even though our flaws aren't on display for the world to see, they are still there. And so we pray. Let us also stand in the gap and pray for salvation for the **Men of this city!** Not to limit God, but to have a clear and precise target for the jurisdiction we have been given individually and under our leader Dr. Mark Ellis. Agreement in this prayer is critical!

Principles, Teachers, Business Leaders, Managers, Government officials, Pastors, Head of household, ALL MEN, etc...**John 14:6** Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. **Matthew 7:21-23 KJV** *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.*

**WEEK 4: Kingdom Impact** through **Endurance**. **Galatians 6:9 KJV** *And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.* It's a reminder that good things take work. And, often, they take a lot of work. But that doesn't mean your efforts are fruitless. An entire apple tree is inside a tiny little seed. But, you can't just crack the seed open and have the full tree pop out. Unrevealed until its season, something God alone can see." It takes time, patience, nurturing, and protection. But when you reap that harvest, it is so worth the effort! **2 Corinthians 4:16-18 KJV** *For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.* All of the outward things we work so hard to achieve (goals, better-paying jobs, a bigger house, etc) are temporary. The things we see are just a tiny fraction of the big picture that God sees. But who we are, our identity in Christ, is the big picture. Fix your eyes on Christ and align your goals with Him!

**WEEK 5:** Love will cause **Kingdom Impact**, so then let love be the highest motivation. Love is a fundamental characteristic of who God is. Everything God does is impelled and influenced by His love. God was motivated by love to save the world (John 3:16) likewise love should power us to do the same **Romans 5:5 KJV** *and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.* **1 Peter 4:8 ESV** *Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.* **Matthew 22:37-40 KJV** *Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.*
