2 Samuel 24: 10-25

Thesis: Many problems facing people today are the results of lives not in synch with God’s will. We want both the things of the Lord and the things of the world. Most of the time, Christ is not at the center of our lives. If we want our lives to be full and meaningful, we must make Christ the center of our lives. 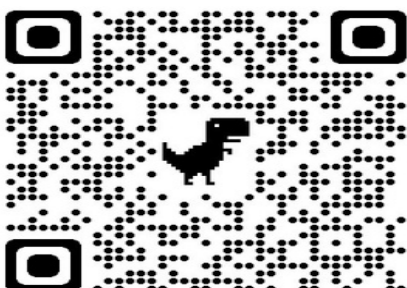
