“Abel Speaks!”

Hebrews 11:4

Thesis: We have just celebrated Memorial Day this week — a time for remembering our loved ones that have lived and died in battle. Today let’s look at the very first family who lost a son in battle. Able was the first casualty in a righteous cause. Man’s sinful nature causes this tragedy over and over again. This fallen son speaks to all of us this morning. What message does Able have for us this Memorial Day Week?

I. Able Speaks to Us of the Sinfulness of Man

- A. The fall in Genesis 3; violence in Genesis 4
- B. Sin was — and still is the problem in society
- C. Christ came to pay for sins and change our hearts

II. Able Speaks to Us of the Shortness of Life

- A. Hewas a young man when he died
- B. Jesus offers eternal life
- C. Are you prepared for eternity?

III. Able Speaks to Us of Salvation Through Faith

- A. Though very young, he was ready to meet God
- B. He came to God with his sacrifice in faith

IV. Able Speaks to Us of the Span Righteous Life

- A. He lived a short time but he still speaks today
- B. What are YOU doing that will endure?

Life Application: Has Able spoken to you by his example? The world we live in today is just like the world Able lived in. The people were sinners — by nature and by choice — just like today. Cain represented evil — Able represented goodness but only because of God’s goodness, not his own. Today sin is present, life is short, salvation is available and the righteousness of Jesus can be ours. How will you respond?

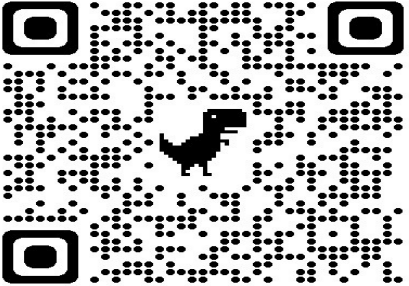
