After all, soul winning is not limited to preachers or church leaders; it is the responsibility of every believer. Furthermore, because this workshop will encourage participating members to see themselves as a vital part of God's saving work, it also aligns with our College Church Discipling 3,000 project. If we desire a growing, vibrant church, we must be a congregation of committed soul-winners/disciple-makers. Come prepared to learn, be encouraged, and be challenged to lovingly share the greatest message the world has ever known.
