QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION AND ONLINE GIVING

Here are two comments that might be helpful as you consider making a pledge or a contribution to the building campaign:

If you are 70 1/2 or older, you can make a Qualified Charitable Distribution directly from an IRA to the church and the funds—up to \$111,000 (\$222,000 for a married couple)—will not be considered taxable income. This process also satisfies the Required Minimum Distribution and has proven to be an advantage for several donors making significant contributions to the campaign.

If you are planning to make a sizable contribution, you might want to do so by check, since there is a fee (approximately 3%) for each online transaction. If you don't add that fee onto your gift total, then your gift will be reduced by 3%. For a large campaign gift, 3% is a significant amount. For more information, check with the church office.
