SUBSPASH IS COMING

Subsplash is a software company whose mission is to "Glorify God and proclaim Jesus is Lord." Its strategy is to "leverage technology to help churches make disciples." Within the next several weeks, College Church will launch a renovated web site and a new app powered by Subsplash that will, we believe, greatly enhance our mission to connect with "God, His Word, His world, and each other."

Our current web site will be refashioned to serve as a "digital doorstep" for visitors and seekers. The new app will be the "living room" for members, featuring more complete, easily accessible information and communication tools.

This "College Church App" will be the hub for comprehensive content: a digital Bible, an upgraded member directory with complete information in one place, a list of groups (Bible classes, shepherding groups, etc.), a link for online giving, as well as sermon and bulletin material.

Not only can members access this content; they can also engage with it—and with other people.

Emailing and messaging can be done from within the app. Group chats that include prayer requests may be set up. You can register for events and join Bible classes or small groups. A "scripture-tagging" feature enables members to locate specific biblical passages in archived sermons. Classes can upload Bible-reading plans. You can live-stream directly on phones, tablets and televisions that have the app, which also enables staff to post sermon video clips on Facebook or Instagram.

For staff and ministry leaders—for any member, the possibilities of connection are abundant.

What's more, this secure and spacious living room belongs solely to our members, even retains our familiar colors and graphics. It fits in your smart phone and can be accessed with one click.

Staff members are working with Subsplash to transfer data to the new software, but the changeover will take time to complete. Thus the launch of the new web site and app will be gradual, with not every feature available immediately. Also, because even a unified digital site can be a challenge, the Communication Ministry is preparing a series of help videos and planning in-person tutorials for classes and individuals as needed.

Members who don't have smart phones will still have access to most news and bulletin content online. We will also reach out to those who have no on-line presence so that they are not left behind.

Subsplash is coming to College Church, confirming digital technology as a significant fact of life in the 21st century. Like older technologies, it can be used for good or ill. God willing, our new app becomes a tool facilitating spiritual nourishment in our "living room" and equipping us to welcome the wide world just beyond our doorstep.
