HUMANITARIAN BUCKETS FOR UKRAINE

Beginning this Sunday, our church will be participating in a special opportunity to provide humanitarian aid to people impacted by the war in Ukraine.

Pick up a bucket and the approved supply list at the designated collection area. Fill the bucket with only the requested items and return it by July 12, 2026.

Important reminders:

- Use only the items listed on the approved supply sheet.
- Do not include food, books, Bibles, brochures, or other unapproved items.
- A brief personal note of encouragement may be included if desired.
- Shipping restrictions require that all buckets contain only approved supplies.

These buckets will be distributed to immigrants, soldiers, displaced persons, and other victims of war in Ukraine.

To help you get a head start, we have attached a PDF copy of the approved supply list so you can begin shopping now.
