Our annual GCS special offering will take place on October 19, 2025. It isn't too early to begin praying for this God-glorifying event!

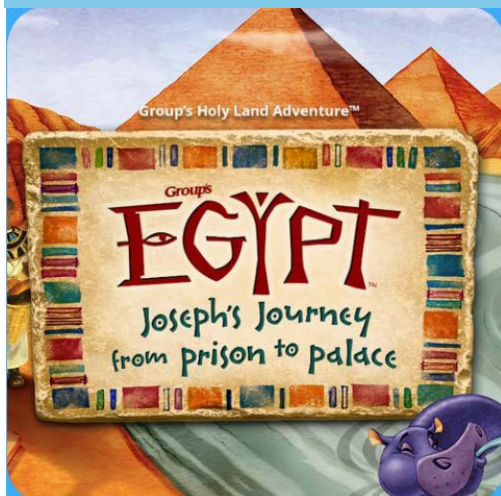
