EVERTT HUFFARD, OUR JULY 8TH SPEAKER

Dr. Evertt W. Huffard is a respected educator, speaker, and church consultant who has devoted his life to developing Christian leaders and advancing the mission of the church around the world. He served for 32 years at the Harding School of Theology, where he was Professor of Leadership and Missions and later Vice President and Dean. During his tenure, he helped shape generations of ministers, missionaries, and church leaders through his teaching, mentoring, and administrative leadership.

Before joining Harding in 1987, Huffard served in a variety of ministry and educational roles, including mission work and theological education in the Middle East. Throughout his career, he has maintained a deep passion for leadership development, church health, and global missions.

Since becoming Professor Emeritus, Dr. Huffard has continued to equip church leaders through consulting, coaching, and teaching ministries. He has worked with congregations and ministry leaders throughout the United States and internationally, helping churches strengthen their leadership and mission through engaging presentations on these topics. He is also well known for leading numerous tours of Bible lands.

Dr. Huffard and his wife, Ileene, have three children and ten grandchildren, and they now live in Searcy, AR.
