1) What does Easter Sunday mean to you?

MARK 14:32-42

³² And they went to a place called Gethsemane. And he said to his disciples, "Sit here while I pray." ³³ And he took with him Peter and James and John, and began to be greatly distressed and troubled. ³⁴ And he said to them, "My soul is very sorrowful, even to death. Remain here and watch." ³⁵ And going a little farther, he fell on the ground and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him. ³⁶ And he said, "Abba, Father, all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will." ³⁷ And he came and found them sleeping, and he said to Peter, "Simon, are you asleep? Could you not watch one hour? ³⁸ Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." ³⁹ And again he went away and prayed, saying the same words. ⁴⁰ And again he came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were very heavy, and they did not know what to answer him. ⁴¹ And he came the third time and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and taking your rest? It is enough; the hour has come. The Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners. ⁴² Rise, let us be going; see, my betrayer is at hand."

The Surrender of the King (Mark 14:32–42)

Before Jesus faces the physical suffering of the cross, He wrestles in prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane.

1. The Sorrow of the Savior (v.34) - Jesus says His soul is "very sorrowful, even to death."
2. The Prayer of Submission (v.36) - Jesus prays, "Not what I will, but what you will."
3. The Weakness of the Disciples (vv.37–41) - While Jesus prays, the disciples repeatedly fall asleep.
4. The Courage of Christ (v.42) - Jesus rises to face His arrest and the cross.

Application: Victory over suffering begins with surrender to the Father's will.
