INTRODUCTION



The closing doxology in Hebrews 13:20-21 is beautiful, powerful, and simple. It concludes the book with a reminder that **JESUS PLUS NOTHING EQUALS EVERYTHING!**





Doxological Conclusion

A **doxology** (from Greek *doxa* = glory, *logos* = word) is a **short expression of praise or glory directed to God**. These typically appear at the end of prayers, letters, or theological sections.

Major Differences

Length

From one verse (Phil 4:20) to extended praise (Eph 1:3–14)

Audience

Some to Father, some to Christ, some explicitly Trinitarian

Tone

Prayerful, theological, pastoral, or cosmic

Focus

Creation, redemption, sovereignty, preservation, or future glory
