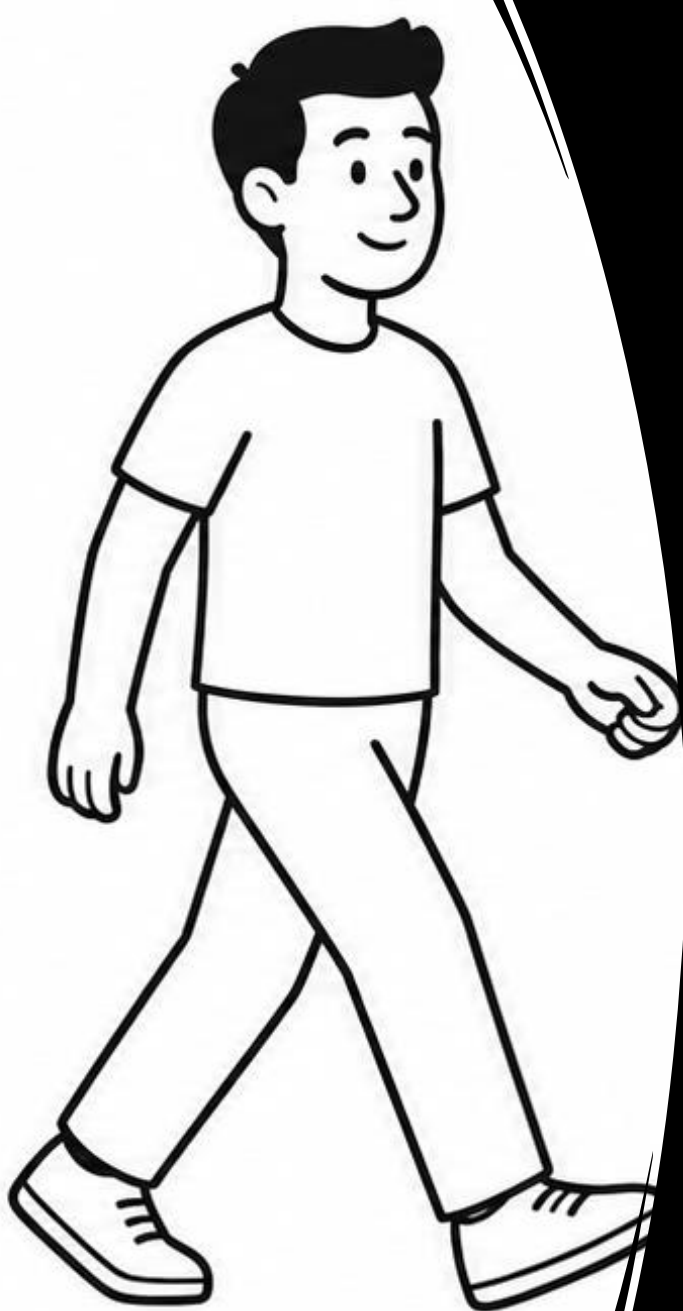
Big Idea:

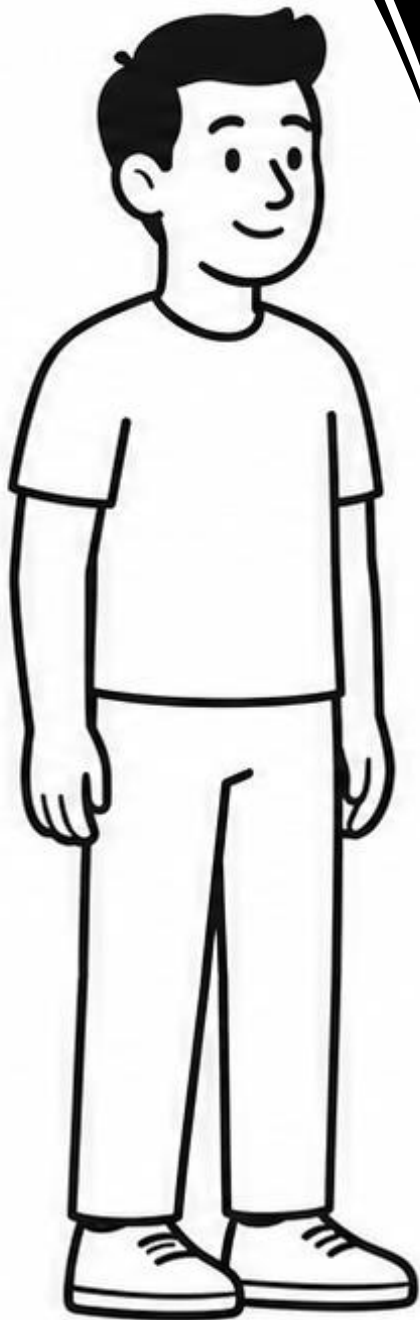

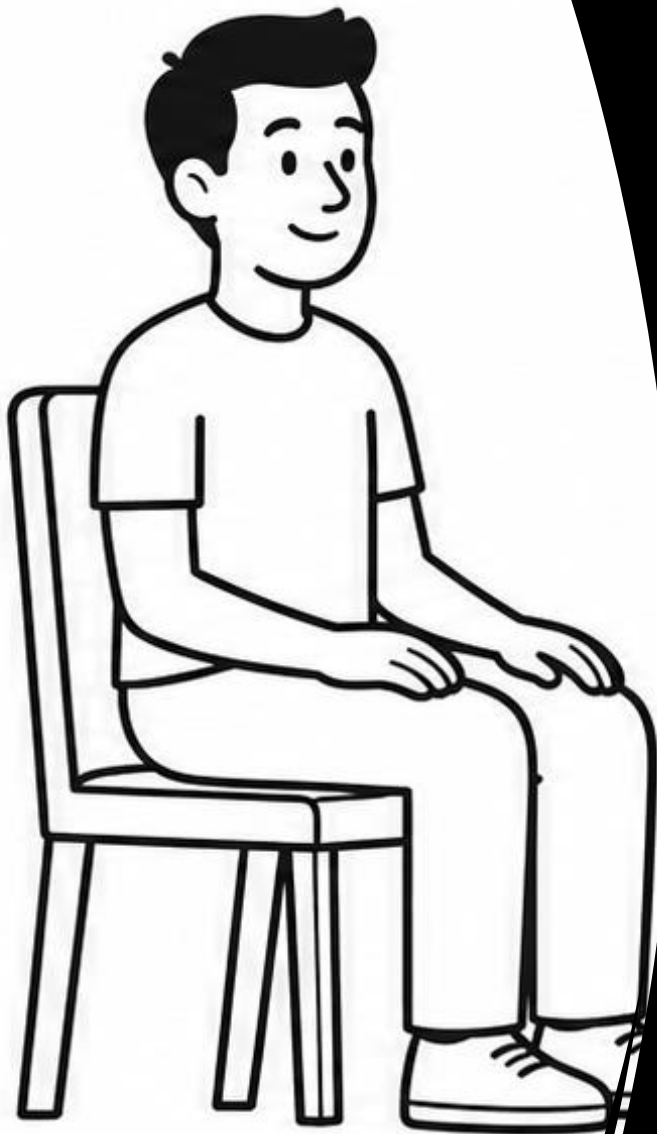

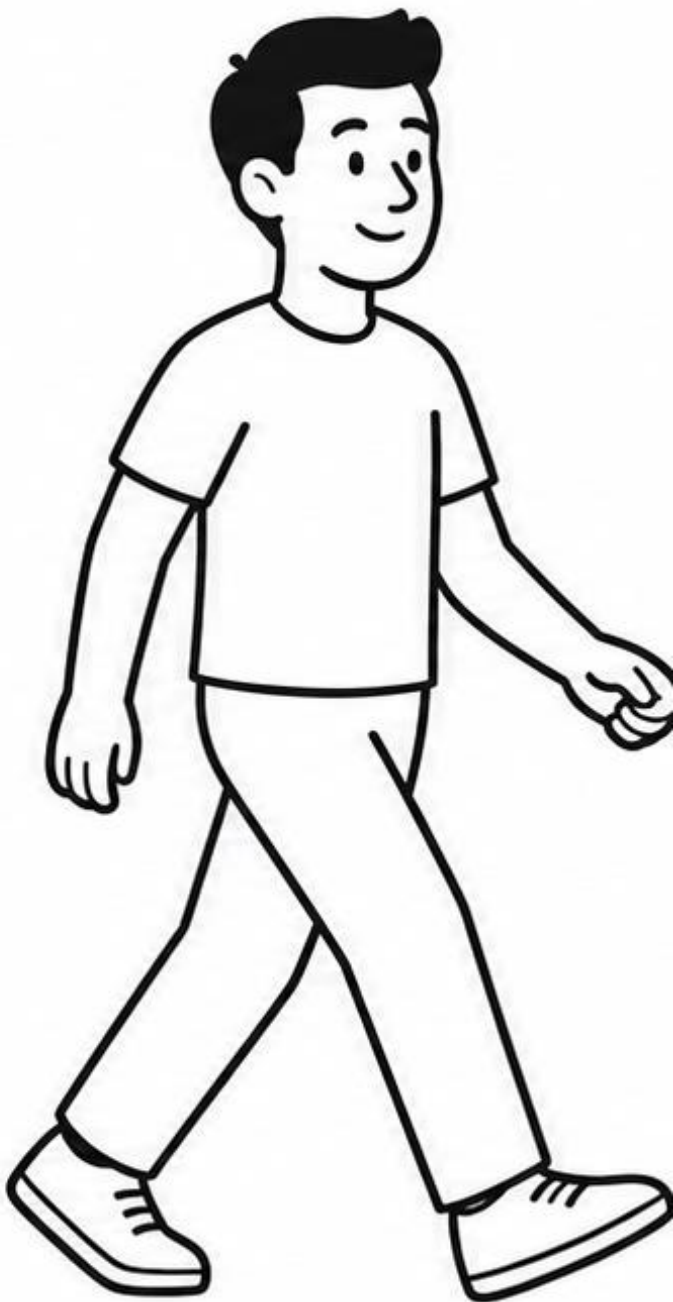

Personal Application:

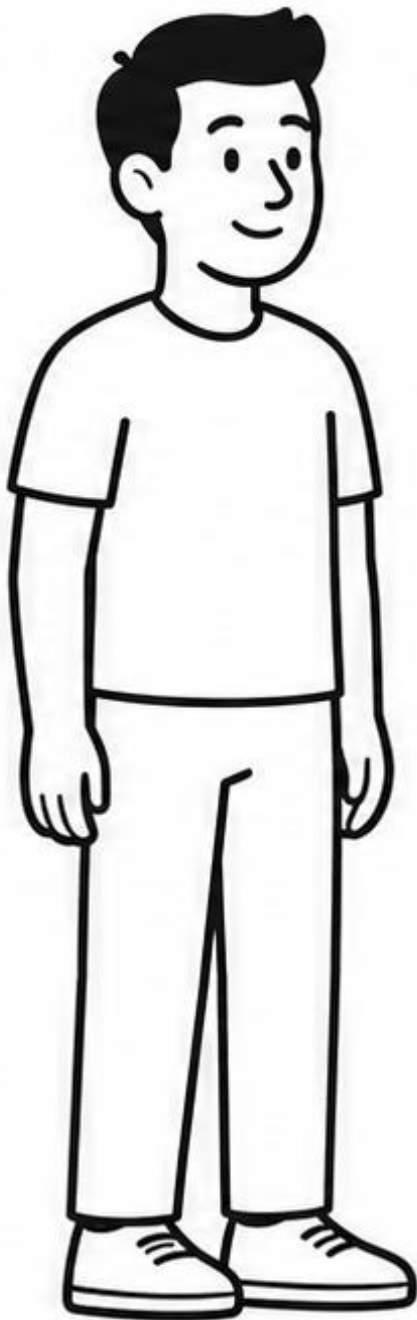
- Do not interpret hardship as God's absence.

Three Summary Conclusions:

Three Summary Conclusions:

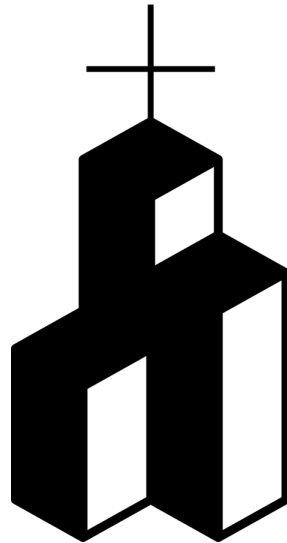
2. **Stand together because the gospel mission is too important to face alone.** The church must strive side by side, not drift apart in fear, preference, or discouragement.



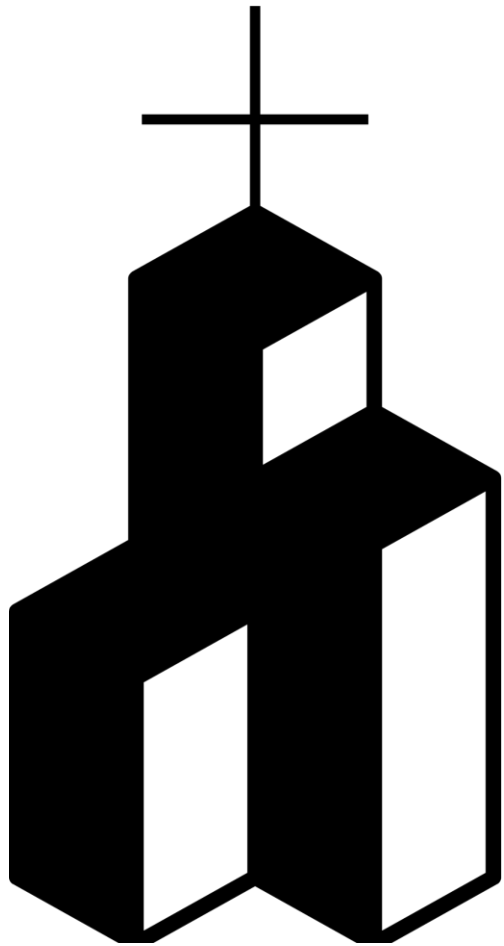
Three Summary Conclusions:

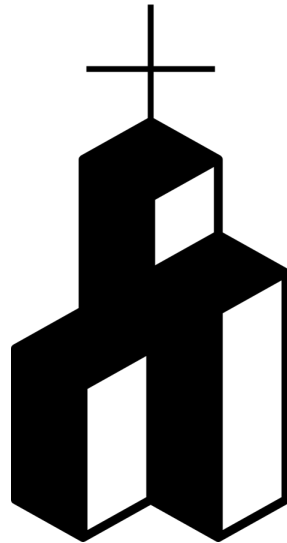

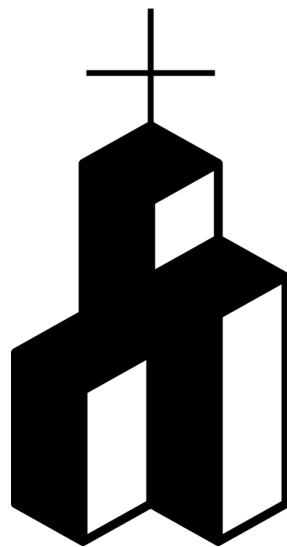

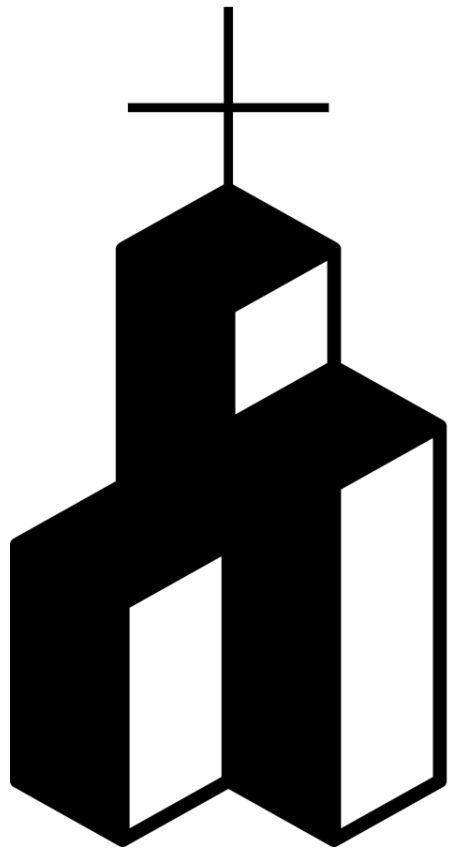
