Theme

God has graciously provided believers with everything necessary for life and godliness through Jesus Christ.

Introduction

Simon Peter writes near the end of his life to strengthen believers against false teaching and spiritual drift. These opening verses are rich with assurance, identity, and spiritual provision.

Main Idea

The message is to all “who have obtained a faith of equal standing with ours..”



2 Peter 1:1-4 (ESV)

What message was Peter wanting us to understand about who he is?

◇ Peter's choice to call himself both a "servant" and an "apostle" is very meaningful.

◇ The two titles together communicate both **humility** and **authority**.

¹ Simeon Peter, a servant and **apostle** of Jesus Christ,

- Greek word translated “**servant**” is ***doulos***, which literally means **slave**.

1. “**Servant**” — **Humble, Submissive, and it declares he is Owned by Christ.**



William Barclay explains what it means to call the Christian the “*doulos*” of God:

- a) He is inalienably (*permanently*) possessed by God.
- b) He is unqualifiedly (*completely*) at the disposal of God.
- c) He owes an unquestioning obedience to God.
- d) He must be constantly in the service of God.

This is striking because Peter was one of the closest disciples of Jesus. He could have emphasized his prominence, yet he begins with humility.

¹ Simeon Peter, a **servant** and **apostle** of Jesus Christ,

2. “Apostle” — Divine Authority and Eyewitness Testimony

- The word “**apostle**” means one who is sent with authority.
- Peter was personally chosen by Jesus, trained by Jesus, an eyewitness of Christ’s ministry, death, resurrection, and glory, commissioned to speak Christ’s truth authoritatively.

Peter is telling his readers:
"What I am writing carries
Christ-given authority."

¹ Simeon Peter, a **servant** and **apostle** of Jesus Christ,

Why Use Both Titles Together?

The combination is powerful.
“**Servant**” prevents pride.
“**Apostle**” establishes authority.

He is saying in effect:

*“I belong completely to Jesus Christ,
and I have been sent by Jesus Christ.”*

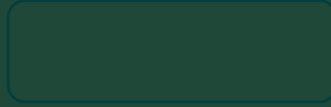

“Peter sets a pattern for all in spiritual leadership: the submissive, sacrificial *humility* of a slave, combined with the dignity, significance, and authority of an apostle.”

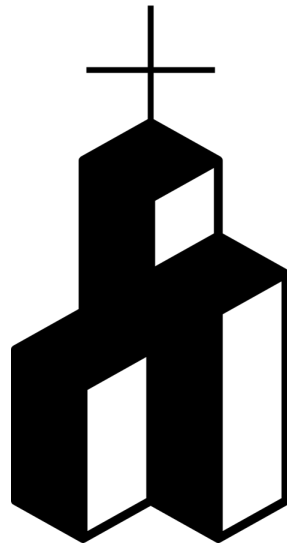

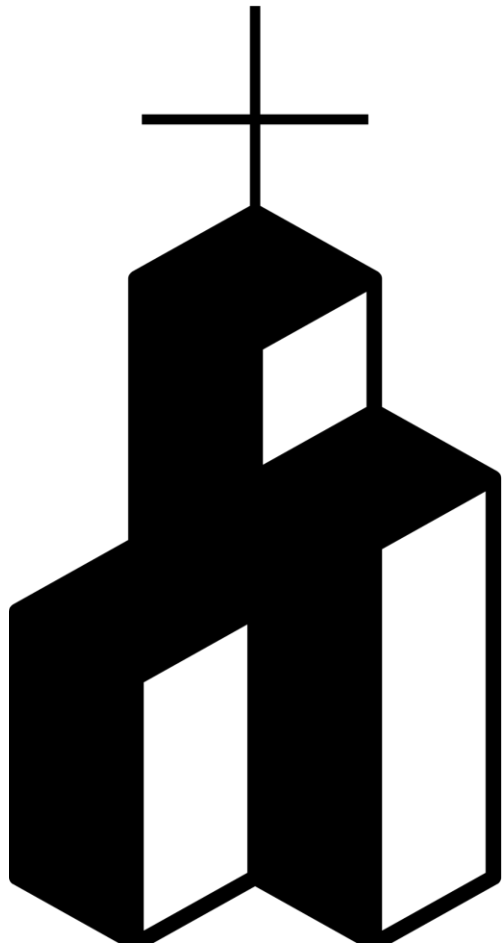

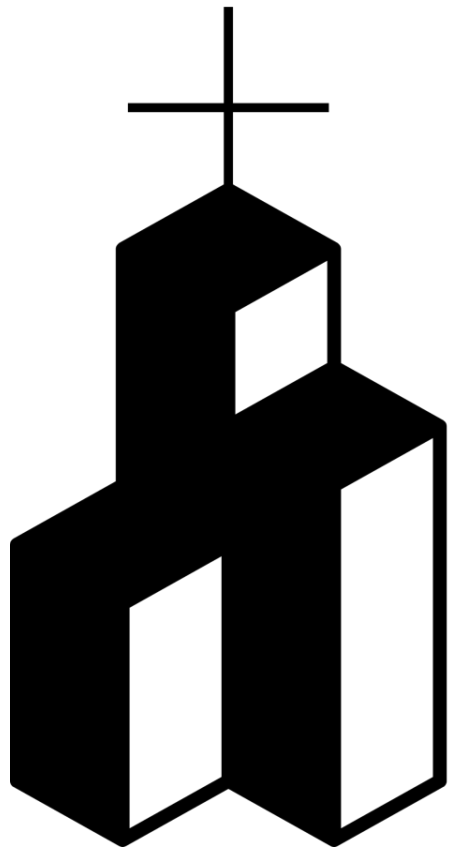
